BRASS LAVER, Christ, our Laver, who contains the cleansing water. Priest washed before entering the Holy Place. After salvation, we need daily cleansing, Ez.36:21-38; Heb.10:22. The Word washes us daily to enter into the service of God, Eph.5:26,27.

ALTAR OF SACRIFICE

Wood (fallen man) Brass (covered by sin). Brass horns on 4 corners (power of sin). Each worshipper killed own sacrifice. Altar (Cross of Christ) animal (Jesus, the Lamb, the ultimate sacrifice to cleanse & forgive, Jn.1:29;Heb.9:22). Burnt Offering: Surrender, Lev.1:3-17. Type of Christ (male stock, without blemish, blood poured out, skin flayed, wood cross, metal nails) John ch.19,20. Meal Offering: Service, Lev.2:1-16. Peace Offering: Serenity, Lev.3:1-17. Sin Offering: Substitute, Lev.4:1-35. Trespass Offering: Satisfaction, Lev.ch.5,6. Atonement, Lev.16:1-34;Heb.9:11-14. Blood of the Lamb, Jn.20:17;Rev.12:11.

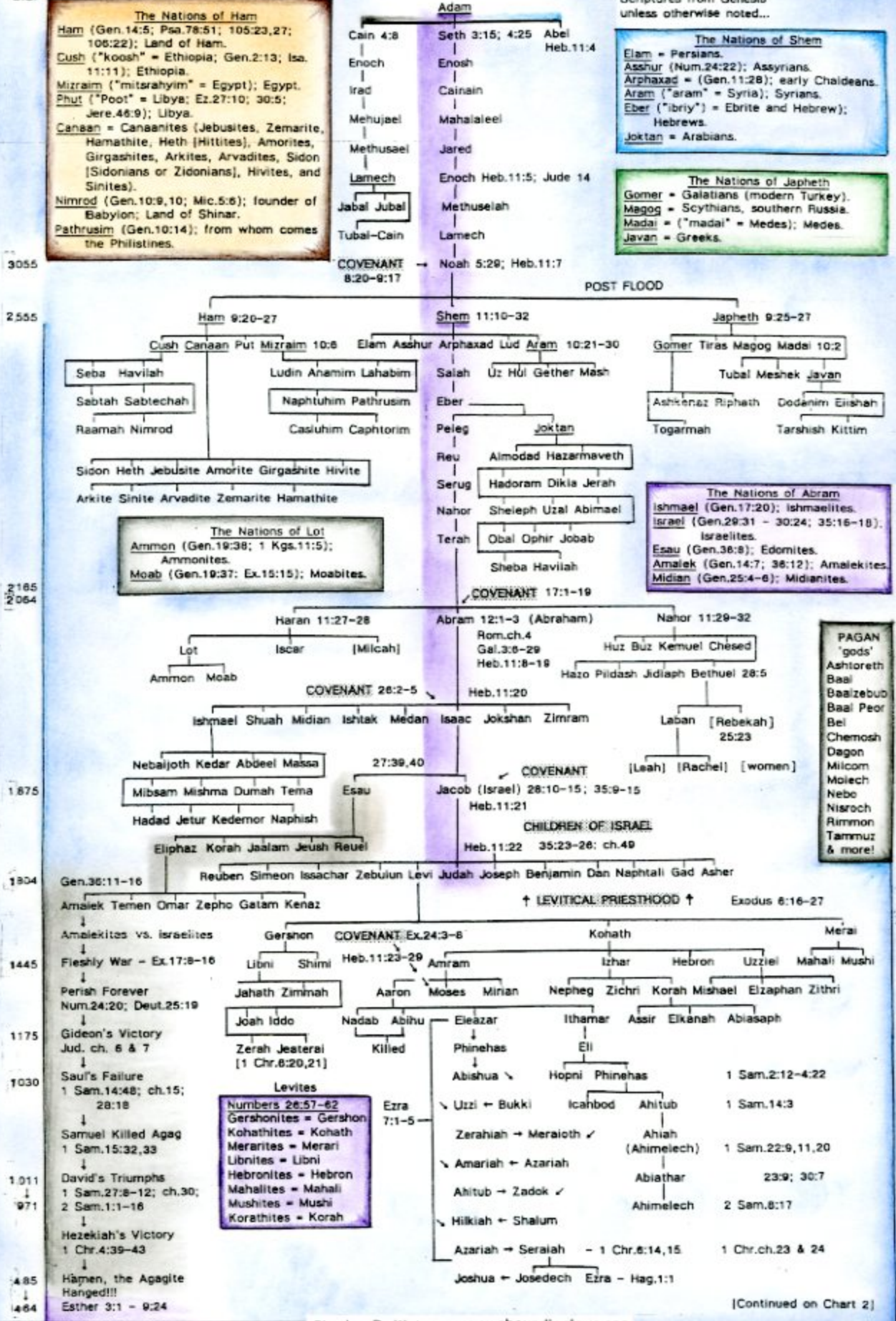

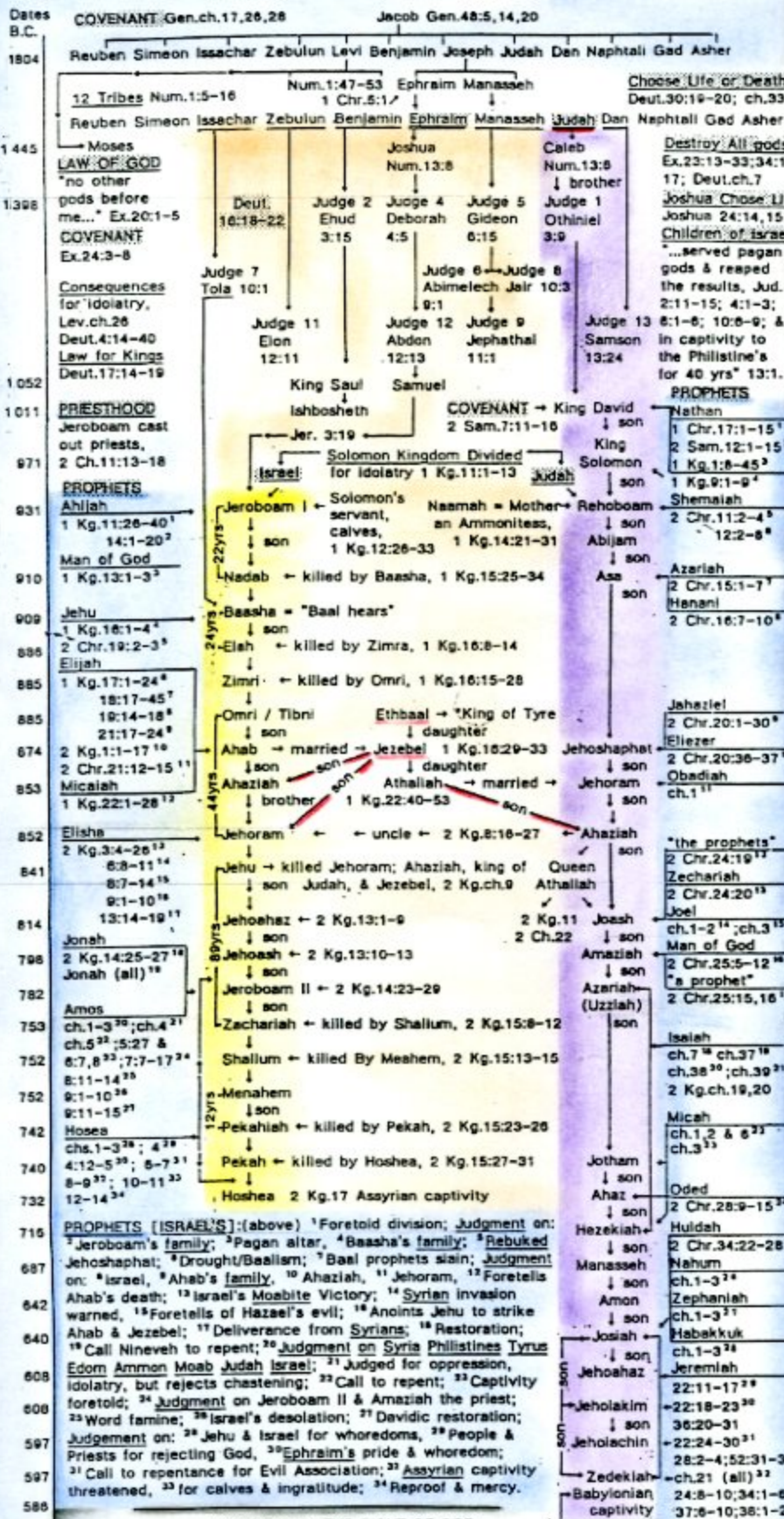

THORNS IN THE FLESH

"...Speak unto the Children of Israel...When you are passed over the Jordan...destroy all pictures, images & high places...But if you will not...[they] shall be pricks in your eyes, and thorns in your sides, and shall vex you..." "KING OF TYRE"

"Thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor with their gods" Ex.23:13-33. Lucifer, supernatural king of Tyre, judged, Ex.ch.28-28. Hiram king of Tyre built David's house, 2 Sam.5:11, built Solomon's temple, 1 Kg.5:1-12, offered land, 9:11, taught shipping trade, 9:28-28 & introduced Ashtoreth & Baaliam, 11:1-8. Ethbaal king of Tyre & Sidon reigned, 18:29-33; 18:19. A Kingdom divided will fall, Matt.12:25.

CHOSE EVIL IN THE SIGHT OF GOD

In Judges, the children of Israel did evil continually in the sight of the Lord. Solomon chose to turn after the gods of his pagan wives. All the kings of Israel chose to do evil, walking in the sins of Jeroboam — pride, lust, and idolatry (pagan gods and the golden calves of Bethel and Dan), causing the people to stumble. All but eight (8) of the kings of Judah did evil, not doing what was right, that is, walking in God's law and the covenant promise, reigning as His kings. The result: captivity, because they rejected the truth.

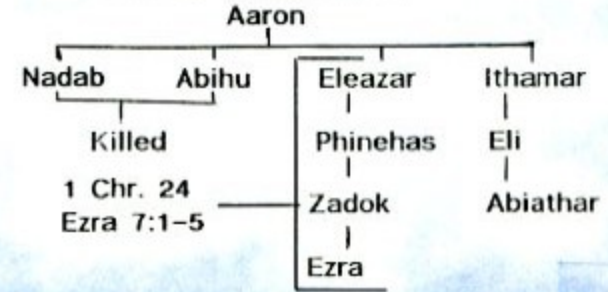

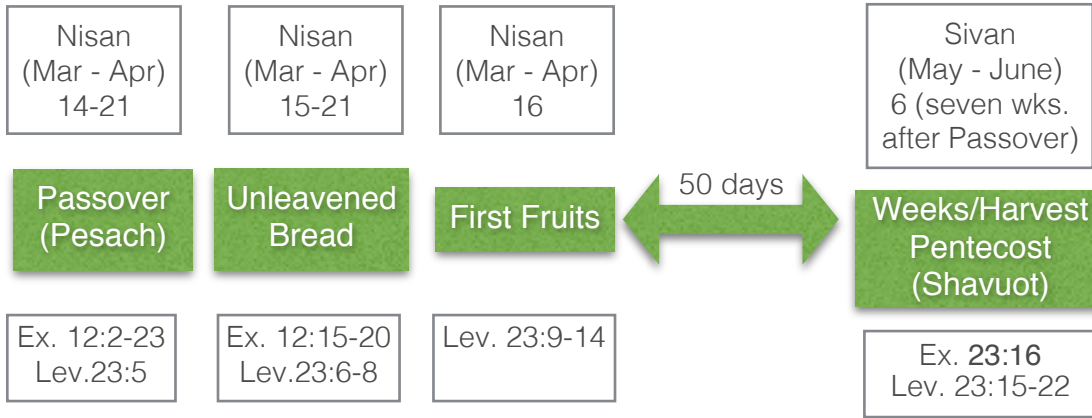

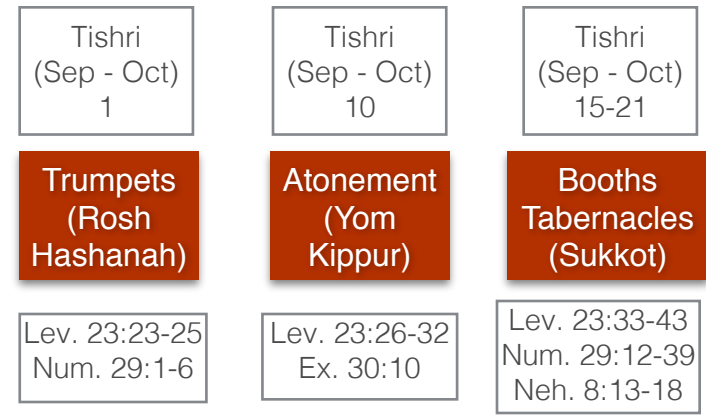
Spring Feasts



Commemorates God's deliverance of Israel and hurried departure out of Egypt. Includes the Day of Firstfruits for the barley harvest dedication.

Commemorates the giving of the Law at Mt. Sinai. Includes a Day of Firstfruits for the wheat harvest dedication (Ex. 34:22)

Fall Feasts



Day of blowing of trumpets signaled a day a rest, presenting offerings to the Lord. Signals the civil new year.

On this day the High Priest makes atonement for his sins, the nation, and the tabernacle. A day of fasting.

Commemorates God's deliverance, protection and provision for 40 years of wilderness wandering, living in booths.
