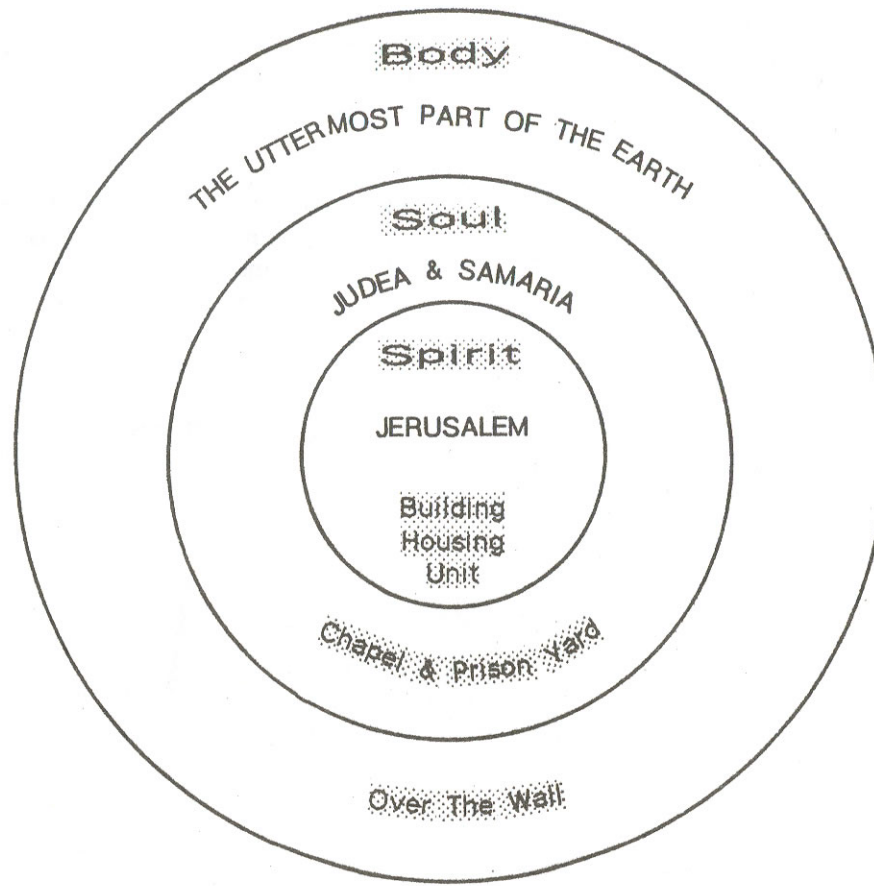


Mending The Body Ministry Priorities



The Body of Christ is made up of local assemblies around the world. The local assemblies in prison meet in the building housing units. These units are the saint's Jerusalem [city of peace] where we are empowered to testify of Christ's finished work at the cross. Jesus said, "*But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth*" (Acts 1:8). We are called to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace and to equip [mend] the saints for the work of the ministry and for the edifying of the body of Christ in love (Eph.4:3,12,16). When the saints are mended in the housing units, the work of the ministry flows out to Judea [the chapel] and to Samaria [the prison yard]. These are God's treasures coming forth as golden lights from prison cells as a Spiritual army taking the Gospel over the walls to the uttermost parts of the earth (2 Chr.16:9).
