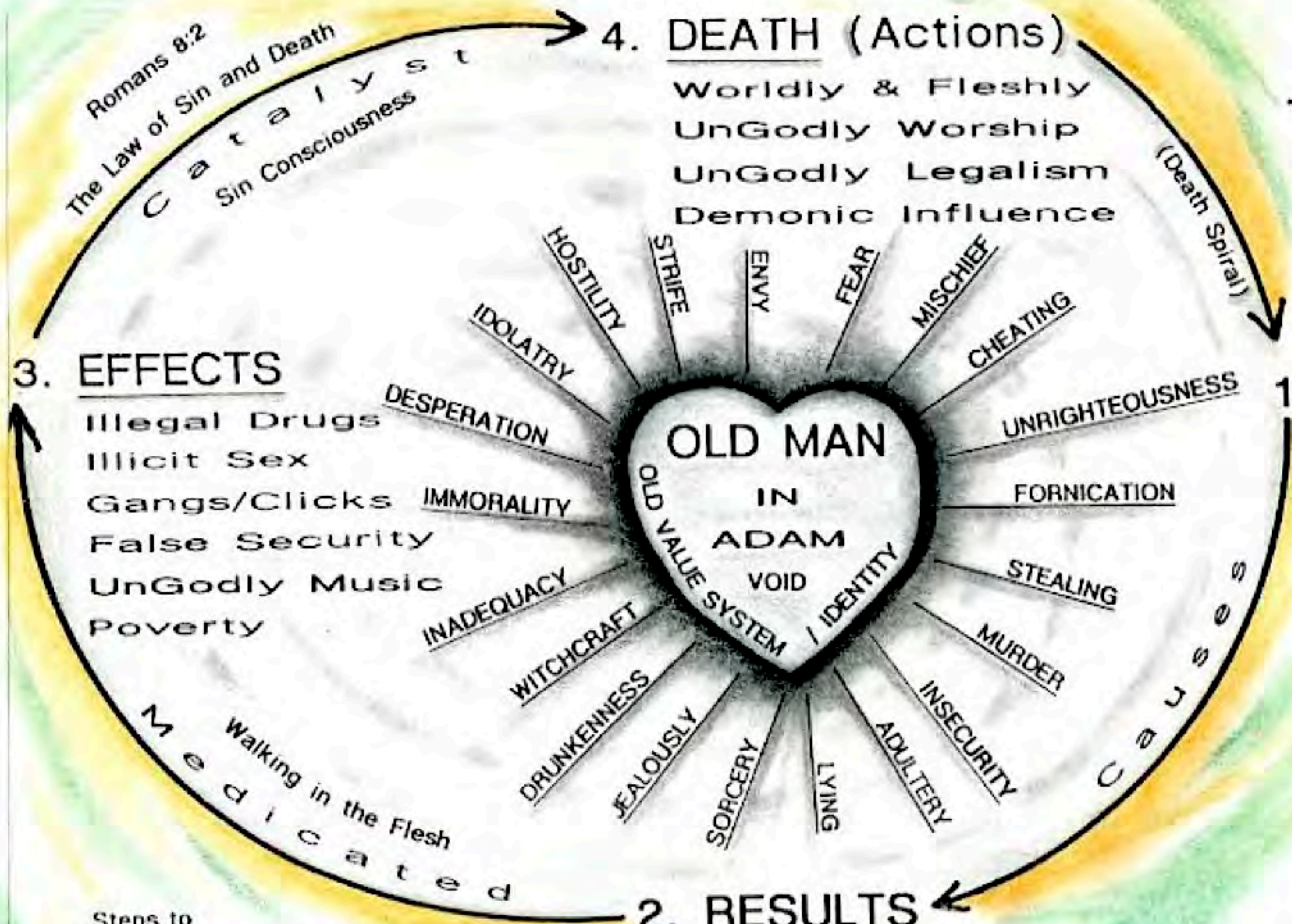


THE CYCLE OF PROGRESSIVE SIN

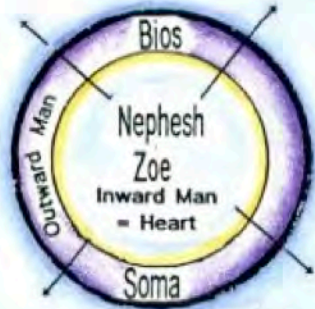

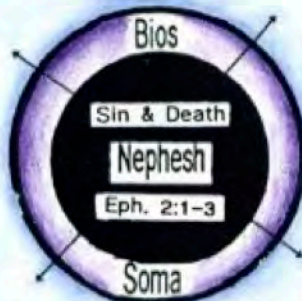

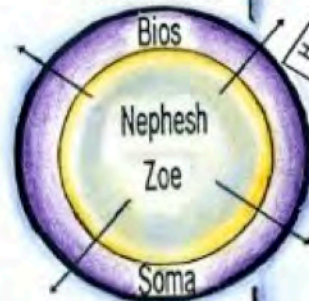

Recovery Glossary

ACCEPTANCE – need for approval, appreciation; favor with one another, but most important, God's favor.
ACCOUNTABILITY – the willingness to give an account for our actions in relation to promises we've made.
AMENDS – a return for (set right) something suffered, usually through the fault of another; restitution.
ANGER – an emotional outrage, often misplaced and released or a pent-up expression of hostility.
ATTITUDE – a firmly-held point of view or way of regarding something. Prideful stand vs. Humility.
"BEAR OUR CROSS" – embrace the humiliation and rejection before us, putting others first, self last.
BELIEF – to place one's trust in God's truth; to take God at His word and trust in Him for salvation.
BITTERNESS – extremely harsh or resentful, marked by intense animosity; a root of unfulfilled revenge.
BONDAGE – to be subject to an owner or master; such as slavery to the slave market of sin.
BROKENNESS – emotionally distressed over sorrow; or sin; contrite spirit; softhearted vessel before God.
CATALYST – something that rouses the mind or spirits or incites to activity; stimulant or impulse.
CHANGE – make over to a radically different state, or disposition; convert, turn, or metamorphose.
CHARACTER – maturity that is refined and revealed through life's tests, humiliations and setbacks.
CHOICE – free will to choose guidance for life from God's promises, our self-will, or circumstances.
COMMITMENT – the singleness of heart and mind that overcomes every obstacle to fulfill the promise.
COMPASSION – to suffer with another; sympathetic feeling for one in distress or unhappy.
CONFESSION – to say the same thing that God says about sin and the solution for sin; declare faith in.
CONTROL – to exercise a decisive role in influencing actions by God's promises, self-will or by chance.
COURAGE – a quality of mind or temperament that enables one to stand fast in the face of opposition.
DENIAL – minimizing, blaming, excusing, generalizing, dodging, and attacking instead of admitting sin.
"DENY SELF" – to say no to self, "if only", blame, anger and depression; humble self, forgive and love.
DEPRESSION – the quality, state, emotion or an instance of being sad; a victim of despair.
DISCIPLINE – to train by instruction and knowledge, or by correction, punishment and reproof.
EFFECTS – a condition, habit, or occurrence traceable to a cause, such as sin and its effects.
EMOTIONS – an intense feeling; internal response or reaction to thoughts we choose to think upon.
EMPATHY – a feeling for or a capacity for experiencing the feelings and thoughts of another.
ENDURANCE – the capacity to bear something painful, unpleasant, or difficult; to suffer patiently, tolerate.
FAITH – being fully persuaded of things hoped for, the conviction of things promised; acting on beliefs.
FEAR – unpleasant emotion caused by a sense of danger; fear of failure; reverence, awe or respect.
FLESHLY – the earthly part of a person, representing lusts and desires, contrary to the fruit of the Spirit.

FORGIVENESS – is releasing another from the debt we believe they owe us; not forgiving binds us to them.
FREEDOM – an attitude of the heart (Truth) that supersedes the external conditions of our lives.
GOODNESS – fruit of the Spirit; praiseworthy character and moral excellence; we're called to goodness.
GRACE – the free gift of God that results in relating to life, even its tragedies, with rejoicing and thanks.
GREED – intense selfish desire beyond reason for possessions and wealth; idolatry.
GUILT – bearing responsibility for an offense or wrongdoing; remorseful awareness of having done wrong.
HELPLESSNESS – unable to effect one's purpose, intention, or end; powerlessness.
HONESTY – free from deception; trustworthy; uprightness as evidenced in character and actions.
HOPE – confident expectancy; firm assurance in things unseen & still in the future; hope comes from God.
HUMILITY – the Spirit of humility in us focuses on God and others rather than on ourselves; denying self.
"IF ONLY" – the first step of the grief process or in dealing with extreme emotional pain and sorrow.
INSANITY – doing the same thing over and over and expecting a different results each time.
INTEGRITY – quality of being honest, sincere, single-minded of purpose; adherence to a code of values.
INVENTORY – a list of weaknesses (wrongs, character defects, shortcomings or faults) and strengths.
JOY – a fruit of the Holy Spirit that is experienced in the presence of God producing strength.
JUSTICE – the practice of doing what is right and just, not getting justice; but to set things right.
LAZINESS – inactivity, idleness, or a refusal to work – a condition condemned by many biblical writers.
LOVE – is God, the foundation upon which all relationships are born and built; sacrificial and never fails.
LUST – desire for what is forbidden; an obsessive sexual craving; contrary to God's will; idolatry.
MEDITATION – to chew on, mutter, to say or roll over and over, think, ponder, listening quietly.
MERCY – to withhold wrath; to show kindness or compassion; pity or leniency; divine blessing.
PAIN – emotion of sorrow; emotional distress or grief, resulting from sin, life's trials or wrong doings.
PASSION – a strong emotion that compels action to reach people with our feelings; enthusiasm.
PATIENCE – fruit of the Spirit; forbearance under suffering and endurance in the face of adversity.
PEACE – combination of hope, trust & quiet in the mind and soul, brought about by reconciliation with God.
PLEASURE – the agreeable emotion accompanying the expectation or possession of something desirable.
PRaise – the language of your faith; an act of worship or acknowledgment by which deeds are extolled.
PRAYER – communication with God; adoration, confession, thanksgiving, requests, dedicated service.
PRIDE – the basic urge to be God, master of our lives; to command and control the universe; arrogance.
PROMISE – the Word sent forth from God for us to expect or to claim the performance of the act.
PURPOSE – to be governed by love; to responsibly love another as I would have another love me.

RANSOM – price paid for the life of another; taking up our cross daily; redemption; the blood of Christ.
REBELLIOUS – resistant or unwilling to submit to the authority of God and man; feel or exhibit anger.
RECONCILIATION – to restore peace in relationships; process where God and man are brought together.
RECOVERY – from a downward death spiral; from self-destruction; from the snare of the devil; healing.
REGENERATION – the change of man's sinful nature by the Holy Spirit in ones life – "being born again."
RELATIONSHIPS – connections between God and others based upon promise, commitment and actions.
REMORSE – distress arising from a sense of guilt; regret for sin or wrongdoing; contrition, repentance.
RENEWAL – reversal, newness, freshness, new lifestyle (way of living), fresh thinking and attitude.
REPENTANCE – to turn from sin to God; change of mind; godly sorrow of remorse for past conduct.
RESOLUTION – to find an answer, explanation or solution for a problem or difficulty.
RESPONSIBILITY – to face the consequences of our choices; fulfilling obligations and duties.
SALVATION – deliverance from the power of sin by the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ for us.
SANCTIFICATION – the on-going process of being continually transformed into the image of Christ.
SELF-CONTROL – fruit of the Spirit; control of actions or emotions by the will; yielding self to God's will.
SELFISHNESS – self-centered; based on looking good, feeling good, being right, and in control; idolatry.
SEPARATION – the quality, state, or condition of being excluded from God's family because of sin.
SERVICE – Christ redeemed us, then commissioned us to join Him in His work for the benefit of others.
SIN – "original sin"; lawlessness; rebellion against God's law in thought, word & deed; moral depravity.
SORCERY – use of drugs to gain supernatural demonic power in order to deceive and charm others.
SORROW – to feel or express deep distress of mind and regret, anguish, grief, heartbreak.
STRONGHOLD – what one uses to defend a personal belief or idea, especially when you are dead wrong.
SYMPATHY – the ability to understand or share the feelings and thoughts of another.
TRUST – trusting God brings peace & contentment; the battle belongs to the Lord; assured hope; reliance.
TRUTH – reality; knowing the truth (God's Word) makes you free; Spiritual revelation of the cross.
VALUES – guiding principles, such as ones old value system vs. the new one after receiving Christ.
VICTIM – one who allows his life to be governed by external circumstances; person killed, hurt or abused.
VICTOR – one who governs himself by his vision and promises regardless of circumstances (Rom. 8:28).
VISION – the redemptive revelation of God; a future of God's provision and relationship with other.
WILLINGNESS – consisting of or proceeding from an exercise of free will; readiness; without reluctance.
WISDOM – the ability to make choices and reach conclusions and decisions from God's point of view.
WORSHIP – reverent devotion pledged to God; denotes the worth of the one receiving the special devotion.
