Confession is saying what God says in His Word about us. We must agree with God and begin to say the same thing that He says. We are not trying to get God to respond to us, but we are responding to what He did 2000 years ago by grace through faith in His finished works at Calvary."...let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes. Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy." **Ephesians 4:23, 24**

Let us now go into scriptures concerning the words of our mouth about who we are in Christ Jesus, our healing through salvation, and our abundant prosperity as Sons of God. We must begin to confess these things out loud as Paul wrote, "...that the *sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgement of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.*" **Philemon 6**. Faith only appropriates what God has already provided by grace.

The dictionary says that to confess means " to make confession of one's faults; to acknowledge faith in ." We are much aware of what it means to confess our faults to God and to one another. However, this tract will consider what it means, "to acknowledge faith in" through the confession of our mouth. **Romans 10:8-10**

Confession means to speak the same thing as another; to agree with someone else (lit. "same-speak" in the Greek N.T.) This someone that we are to speak like and agree with is our Father God – His Word. "The word is alive and powerful, sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword." **Hebrews 4:12** The sword of the Spirit is our tongue speaking the Word of God, putting on the armour of God. **Ephesians 6:10-18**
