II. THE GOSPEL

A. Grace

"not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior, that having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life." Tit. 3:5-7; Prov. 14:12.

C. God

- 1. He is merciful and does not want to punish man. "The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance."2 Pet. 3:9; Jer. 31:3
- 2. He is just and will surely punish sin. "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Rom. 6:23; Ex. 34:7; Rom. 2:2

D. Christ
