What is in a person's name?

It represents everything a person IS and DOES. With Steve Jobs, we think Apple. Bill Gates, we think Microsoft Windows and riches, plus various other thoughts concerning both men.

How about Jesus Christ? Hopefully, we think of His healing ministry, feeding the hungry, His crucifixion, death, burial, resurrection, and how He took our place on the cross for our sin. "Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." (Phil. 2:9–11). His name is above every name; cancer, AIDS, lust, drugs, alcohol, suicide, demons, and every name.

Our High Priest

Because of the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ, He has become the High Priest of our profession and intercessor (Hebrews 3:1; 7:25).

He presented His redemptive blood before the heavenly throne of God and fifty days later ushered forth the Holy Spirit (Acts 2). Those who receive Him become New Creations (2 Cor. 5:17). Now we are risen in Christ and all He did for us! He has given us provisions in His name that we are to appropriate (take for our own) by faith on a daily basis. Overcomers By The Blood

Let us look at the blood of Jesus Christ, God's ultimate power over demonic forces and see if we are truly applying its power by faith in our lives.

Deliverance

Jesus Christ is our Passover Lamb. Every person should study the divine order of the Passover as it is given in Exodus 12. Take the Lamb (Christ), sprinkle the blood (by faith), eat the Lamb (nourishment by the Word), remove the leaven (be cleansed), bitter herbs (enduring suffering), and be ready to leave (the old life of sin).

The blood of the Covenant brings us out of the wilderness and into the presence of God for life's journey. Once you realize what Jesus actually meant when He said, "This is the New Covenant established in my blood," your life will never be the same again.

Presence of God

In the Old Testament sin offering, the blood covered the sin and God revealed His glory. Jesus Christ, our sin offering, entered into God's presence. As priests, our act of faith in Christ, brings us into God's presence and glory.

So let us come boldly to the throne of grace that we may obtain mercy and grace in time of need (Hebrews 4:16). As we choose His presence, there is victory.

Victory

This is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith (1 John 5:4). We overcome the world of temptation by faith in the blood and by our testimony of the blood Scriptures below. Don't stay in the wilderness and outside the presence of God. Giant conquering faith is yours as you walk in faith with the blood of Christ.

THE BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST

Gen. 4:3-5 - Abel's sacrifice was offered by faith (Heb. 11:4), with an attitude pleasing to God.

Gen. 8:20-22 - Noah recognized by faith the blood sacrifice as God's divine provision.

Gen. 12:1-3 - Abraham rejoiced by faith foreseeing his promised redeemer, Jn. 8:56; Gal. 3:8,9,29.

Ex. 12:1-13, 21-24 - Moses took the Lamb (a type of Jesus), applied the blood and overcame by faith.

Ex. ch. 24 - Moses applied the blood of the covenant and entered into the presence of God's glory.

Ex. ch. 29 - Aaron offered blood to cleanse himself and to sanctity the tabernacle by God's glory.

Zec. 9:11,12 - The blood brings us out of the pit with no water to provide a double blessing.

Matt. 26:28 - The blood of the new covenant is poured out to forgive the sins of many.

John 1:29 - The blood of the Lamb of God takes away the sins of the world; Rev. 13:8.

John 6:29-56 - I believe in Jesus Christ and partake in His body and blood for eternal life.

Acts 20:28 - I am purchased from the slave market of sin with the blood of Jesus Christ.

Rom. 3:24-26 - I am justified by grace, redeemed by Christ and declared righteous by faith.

Rom. 5:9 - I am made right in God's sight by the blood of Christ and saved from His judgment.

1 Cor. 6:19, 20 - I am bought with a high price. I glorify God in spirit and body which is God's temple.

1 Cor. 10:16 - I am blessed because I share in the benefit of the blood of Jesus Christ.

1 Cor. 11:25 - I have in remembrance who I am in Christ because of the blood of the new covenant.

Eph. 1:7,14 - I am purchased by grace, free through the blood of Jesus and my sins are forgiven.

Eph. 2:13 - I am God's property, once far away, but now I'm near to God by the blood.

Col. 1:14,20 - I have peace with God through the blood of the cross, reconciled to God.

Heb. 9:12-14 - Jesus took His blood into heaven's Most Holy Place, securing my salvation forever. His blood purified my heart from dead works to serve and worship the true and living God.

Heb. 9:21, 22 - I am forgiven of my sins which would be impossible without the shedding of blood.

Heb. 10:19, 20 - I have boldness to enter heaven's Most Holy Place because of the blood of Jesus. I have a new and living way to enter into God's presence through the sacred veil by Jesus' death.

Heb. 12:24 - I have come to Jesus, the mediator of the new covenant and forgiven by His blood.

Heb. 13:12 - I am set apart unto God and made holy by the blood of Jesus who suffered for my sin.

Heb. 13:20 - I have an everlasting covenant, signed in Jesus' blood, the great Shepherd of the sheep.

1 Pet. 1:2 - I am made holy by the Spirit, because I have been cleansed by the lifeblood of Jesus Christ.

1 Pet. 1:19 - I am paid for with the precious blood of Jesus, the sinless, spotless Lamb of God.

1 Jn. 1:7 - I have fellowship with God, because the blood of Jesus cleanses me from all Sin.

Rev. 1:5, 6 - I am loved and washed from sin by Jesus' blood, Who made me a king and priest.

Rev. 5:9 - I am blood bought for God's purpose, causing me to reign as a priest in God's kingdom.

Rev. 12:11 - I overcome the devil by the blood of the Lamb and the word of my testimony.

Daily Steps

- 1. Meditate these Blood Scriptures
- 2. Recognize that you are bought with a price and brought into the presence of God.
- 3. Confess each Scripture with our mouth daily. God's glory and presence will follow.
- 4. Pray from your throne room position in the Name of Jesus Christ.
- 5. Praise God with the revelation of being seated with Christ in the heavenly places because of the blood of Jesus.

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
